OBJECTIVES

The objective of the International Seminar in European Project Planning is to provide participants with the skills to plan and write European project proposals.

The programme addresses topics such as: Analysis of funding opportunities in the fields of Education and Research; Matching ideas with funding programmes; Understanding of calls for proposal; Development of effective project ideas; Creation of transnational partnerships; Planning the project budget; Filling in the Application Form; Project self-assessment; Quality issues and best practice; The project submission process; Award and selection criteria.



TARGET GROUP

Since the first edition of the International Seminar in European Project Planning, organised in 2004, over five-hundred participants of 40 nationalities, worldwide, were involved.

The international seminar is addressed to school directors, managers, lecturers, teachers, trainers, researchers and experts working in public bodies, universities, schools, training organizations, adult education institutions, research centers.

The European Project Planning international Seminar is addressed to individuals who wish to acquire the skills for successfully accessing and managing European funds in the field of education and research.

ORGANIZATION

Dates

The dates of the 2021 edition of the International Seminar in European Project Planning is:

Asynchronous online participants can start anytime.

Duration

The seminar has a total duration of one week, 30 hours organized in 6 modules.

Onsite and Online Attendance Options

The seminar is offered either as a classroom-based or online-based course.

It is up to each participant to decide whether to enrol for the online or onsite course.

The classroom-based programme is held in Florence (Italy).

The online course is organised via a dedicated e-learning platform. It is possible to attend the online course both synchronously (i.e. at the same time as the classroom programme) and asynchronously (i.e. the student decides when to attend the pre-recorded lectures and individually carries out the practical activities).

Methodology

The approach used, for both the classroom and online solutions, is based on a constant integration of theory with **practical, hands-on experiences**. **Practical simulations** are carried out for each topic analysed. The practical simulations also make use of the services, databases and documentation made available, online, by the European Commission and its Agencies.

Networking opportunities are provided for both onsite and online participants in the framework of a highly interactive learning environment.

Location

The classroom-based part of the the International Seminar in European Project Planning is held at Pixel, **in Florence (Italy).** Pixel headquarters are near the historical city centre of Florence. The online course is organised via a dedicated highly interactive **e-learning platform.**

Language

The International Seminar in European Project Planning is delivered in English.



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The **online programme** is organised, at the same time as the classroom programme, via a **dedicated e-learning platform** already successfully tested in the framework of previous online courses delivered by Pixel that, due to the Covid-19 situation, were organised entirely online.

It is possible to attend the **online programme, either synchronously or asynchronously**. All lectures are recorded, and all teaching materials and documents are available online, so it is possible to access both lectures and materials anytime and asynchronously. Participants can also ask questions asynchronously by contacting the course trainers who responds the day after.
